Introduction:

Hello! Thank you for participating in the first ever online Global Innovation Camp. We have more than **80 participating schools** from around the world!

We are excited to learn about and investigate real-life problems that affect both of our local and global communities with your amazing class. In this Online Camp, we aim to help our students become agents of change and become problem-solvers. However, more than that, we also want them to appreciate the only world that we have.

This Innovation Camp will be delivered primarily as a blended learning activity, where there will be online learning activities and face-to-face activities, where teachers, like you, still acts as the primary facilitator of learning. There will be opportunities to connect participating schools to one another in the name of global learning and sharing.

Lessons are to be facilitated once a week in order to accommodate the different class schedules of every participating teacher and his/ her class. For every lesson, a learning task will be given for students to accomplish. Deadlines for tasks will be identified every week. Lessons can be facilitated for 40-50 minutes, but this may change according to the needs of your students and your preference. The important thing is to consider the set learning outcomes, objectives, and weekly output, which we will be shared to the bigger community.

Basic steps in facilitating the weekly learning:

1. Teacher visits the official website (<https://kidsanproject.weebly.com/online-innovation-camp-lesson-guide.html>) to check on the posted weekly lesson plan guide. Go through the plan and download the required and suggested materials. **Modify lesson guide according to your student's needs.**

2. Teacher conducts and facilitates lesson to his/ her class. Teacher documents the lesson activities via photos or videos.
 - a. If there are Skype activities, we will be asking for your schedule so that we can connect you to other schools or guest speakers.
 - b. Kids Can Innovation Camp Ambassadors will also be given opportunity to connect with your students so they can also share about the importance of learning about and acting on the SDGs and becoming agents of change.

3. Teacher sends weekly output to francisbtuscano@gmail.com for recognition of class work and effort, and for posting on the Innovation Camp's official website and social media. A weekly badge will be awarded to your class also!

Weekly lesson guides will be put up on the official website a week before the expected schedule. This is to help teachers prepare for the upcoming lesson activities. However, in recognition of the different school timetables that we have across the world, please do not feel constraint by the ideal lesson time set in the lesson guides. Adjust the timetable for your class accordingly. However, still make sure that you send us your weekly output and updates.

Last, if classes in your school have not started yet the moment the Online Innovation Camp commences, do not worry! The weekly guides will still be in the website and you can still work on them with your students!
